Under more normal circumstances I would spend a significant part of the day checking items out and taking returns at the circulation desk. I would also be fielding phone calls and answering reference questions.

One of my favorite parts of the job is putting together our DVD and CD orders and then cataloging those items when they arrive. I also catalog our fiction pre-orders in the weeks or even months before

they're published. Then when the books are delivered Lesa (Adult Services) fleshes those records out into their final form. The DVDs and books that we order are typically chosen for their potential interest to library patrons; but if you are curious about a title that the library doesn't then have feel free to reach out. I would also encourage you to check out the library's Facebook and Twitter pages to keep up to date on announcements and events. The Virtual Pickin' in the Park series has kicked back off on Tuesday evenings and you can view that live on Facebook.

On Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays the hours are 9-1, 1:30-3:30, and 4-7:30, with sanitizing breaks at 1:00, 3:30, and 7:30-8 pm. The library primarily offers curb services on Wednesdays and Fridays from 9-5 and Saturdays 10-5.
