## A Desire to See Him

**Luke 9:7-9**, "Now Herod the tetrarch heard of all that was done by him :and he was perplexed, because that it was said of some, that John was risen from the dead; And of some, that Elias had appeared; and of others, that one of the old prophets was risen again. And Herod said, John have I beheaded :but who is this, of whom I hear such things? And he desired to see him."

You would think it a good thing that Herod, or anyone, would have a desire to see Jesus. At first thought it would seem to be the best thing that a person could want to do. However, it could be one of the worst things for the person who wanted this for the wrong reason. Herod definitely was one who wanted to for the wrong reason. **Luke 23:8**, "And when Herod saw Jesus, he was exceeding glad :for he was desirous to see him of a long season, because he had heard many things of him; and he hoped to have seen some miracle done by him."

A miracle was all that Herod wanted to see. He wasn't interested so much in who Jesus was as in seeing a miracle done by him. Herod wanted to be entertained with a show and to see if the things that he had heard were true. Did this evil minded, worldly ruler even think that he had sins and that he needed to be forgiven? He was interested, like so many others, in only what pleased him at the moment. If he gave any thought about Jesus and who he was, there is no indication of it. He was blinded by the thought of getting to see a miracle performed for his pleasure.

Jesus knew when anyone wanted to see Him for some material profit that catered to the flesh. **John** <u>**6:25-26**</u>, "And when they had found him on the other side of the sea, they said unto him, Rabbi, when camest thou hither? Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled." On this occasion they didn't take into consideration that he performed a miracle with the loaves and fish, but only that they had food provided for them. He was telling them that they were not seeking food for the soul, but only wanted him to feed their fleshly bodies.

It is a fact that the body needs to be taken care of with food and the other things that the flesh requires. It is just as important that the spirit needs are met as well. If a person only concerns himself with feeding the body and neglects the spirit then he will leave this life lost and without the Lord. Then will be the realization that a great mistake was made, but at that time it will be too late. Now is the time that each of us should seek the Lord for all of our needs, both physical and spiritual.

People go to church for different reasons, just as people went to see Jesus for different reasons as we read in scripture. This may have helped his business, but if he didn't believe and live for the Lord it wouldn't help his soul.

To be forgiven of our sins and to have our names in the Book of Life will lead us to praise the Lord forever.


