Elisha Witt and his wife Phoebe traveled to Kentucky after the Revolutionary War. He served in the Continental Army from 1776 until 1781 where he was at the Battle of Yorktown. A gravestone was placed for Elisha by DAR members several years ago. Phoebe's grave was only marked by a rock. Thanks to work by local volunteers, and Witt descendants, a grave marker has been purchased and set on Phoebe's grave.

**Note:** We will have a golf cart for those who are not able to walk to the cemetery. We suggest that you wear comfortable walking shoes.

**Directions to cemetery:** From Irvine turn right onto Sand Hill Rd and continue for 3.4 miles. Turn right onto North Sulpher Wells Road. It is a little over a mile till you get to the end of the road. The cemetery will be on your left. From Richmond take 52 East, you will turn left onto Sand Hill Road and follow above directions.
