Opal Riddell, 81

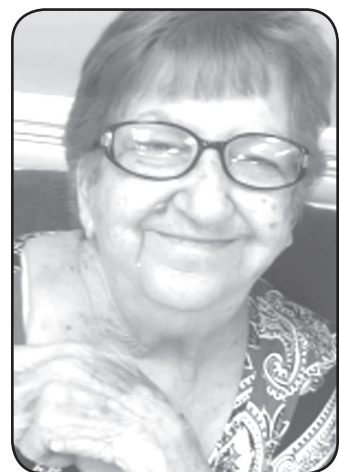
Opal Riddell, age 81, of Pea Ridge Road in Irvine, Kentucky, passed away Saturday, June 12, 2021, at her home following a short illness.
