luck in 2016.

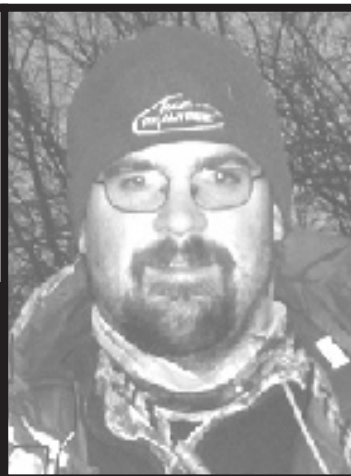
