Modesty?

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<u>**1 Timothy 2:9**</u>, "In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;"

I don't think that I have ever heard much said about modesty in a sermon, either in church or by the preachers on radio and television. Why?
