Three are charged with making meth

Kentucky State Police, assisted by the Estill County Sheriff's Dept., made three arrests on Halloween Eve after finding three active meth labs on Walters Ridge Road.

Trooper T. Robinson wrote in the citations that KSP had received an anonymous tip that methamphetamine was being manufactured in a camper on Walters Ridge Road.

When law enforcement arrived on the scene, the trooper wrote that he observed several subjects inside the camper, and a female had a syringe in her hand.

Trooper Robinson said he knocked on the door, and the people inside began moving rapidly.

The door was opened, and standing outside, the trooper said he observed several

needles in plain sight.

The camper was searched for people only, and the trooper said he located two females and two males.

During the search for people only, Trooper Robinson said he saw in plain sight several precursors that are used in the manufacture of methamphetamine.

The anonymous person giving the tip also stated there was a hunting blind/stand behind the camper, and there was a path leading from the camper to the blind.

The trooper said the hunting blind was believed to have been used for the manufacture of methamphetamine. He stated that he observed from the window the blind and what appeared to be three active meth labs.

Two arrested in pants theft

Pants were stolen from trailers at Carhartt loading dock

Two men were arrested last week for receiving stolen property -- pants stolen from Carhartt, Inc.

Deputy Sheriff Russell Morris arrested Timothy McKinney, 28, of Covey Road, Irvine on Tuesday. The citation states that McKinney had several pairs of the pants in his possession which had been stolen from Carhartt.

McKinney reportedly admitted that he knew the pants were stolen. The pants were valued at over \$500.

The following morning,

Morris arrested Daniel Conrad, 30, and charged him with the same offense.

The citation states that Conrad had several pieces of Carhartt clothes at his residence at 709 Poplar Street, Ravenna.

Conrad reportedly told the deputy that he had sold several pieces of clothing throughout Estill County to different individuals.

About 117 pairs of Carhartt pants in various colors and sizes were reported stolen several weeks ago from the plant on Industrial Drive,

Irvine. The pants were valued to as much as \$55 a pair.

Deputy Randy Farthing took the initial report of the pants stolen from two trailers backed into the loading dock at Carhartt.

The report stated that someone lowered the two trailers and cut foam away from the loading dock to gain entry.

Conrad and McKinney were arraigned in Estill District Court on Wednesday. Each of them pleaded not guilty to receiving stolen property under \$10,000.

Bail was also set for each of them at \$5,000 cash. Conrad was released from custody that day after posting 10% (\$500) of the \$5,000 bond.

Both Conrad and McKinney were scheduled to return to Estill District Court on Nov. 4 for a preliminary hearing.

Conrad was also arraigned on five traffic charges from March 12, 2015 last Wednesday. He plead not guilty to the traffic charges, which will also be on the docket on Nov. 4.
