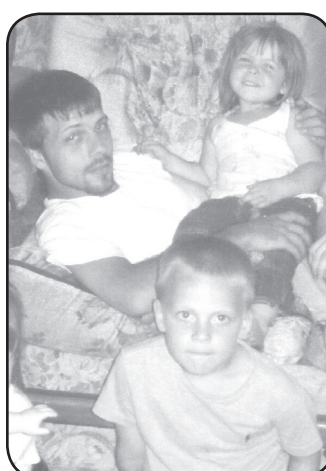
## Scotty Alan "Scooter" Slawson, 29
