Irvine Police Beat

IPD officer John Sturniolo arrested Candic Watts, 28, on an arrest warrant from Powell County on Nov. 15. She was charged with theft by unlawful taking or disposition over \$500 on a Powell County warrant.

Three bench warrants were served Monday, November 16 by Irvine Police Chief Brad Smith on Penny V. Richardson, 43, of Little Rock Road, Irvine.

The Estill District Court bench warrants say that Richardson failed to pay fines and service fees for unlawful transaction with a minor, third degree (2013), operating on a suspended or revoked license and leaving scene of an accident - failure to render aid (2012) and theft by deception including cold checks (2013). The fines totaled \$154 and service fees \$90.

Louis Woosley, 58, of Rosebud Avenue, Irvine, was charged with domestic vio-

lence on Saturday, Nov. 14 by Officer Sturniolo.
