# UK Industrial Hemp Research Progressing In 2<sup>nd</sup> Year

Industrial hemp research at the University of Kentucky is moving along in its second year. Researchers in the University of Kentucky College of Agriculture, Food and Environment have been conducting different hemp projects under the guidance of the Kentucky Department

of Agriculture. While the first year's pilot project was limited to varieties used for fiber production, this year's research trials, led by UKAg agronomists David Williams and Rich Mundell, include hemp varieties used for the production of fiber, grains and cannabinoids. Cannabinoids, such as hemp-based cannabidiol, may be used in food and dietary supplements for consumer health and wellness benefits.

"Our work has expanded tion. greatly this year to include all three harvestable components of hemp," Williams said. "We are hoping to optimize grower profitabilstudies."
