



In the Old Testament book of **Joshua chapter 24**. thinking that his life was fastly coming to an end, Joshua gathered the people together to hear one of his last sermons. This chapter reveals what was upon his mind. First, he reminded them of God's goodness shown by bringing them into the land He had promised through Abraham. Now he also has driven out from before them all the inhabitants who worshipped false Gods. During this he let them take over their homes and olive yards, also the vast vineyards, which they had not had to labor for. Now, he was concerned that they might turn and serve other gods. 
