

The Downfall of America by BOB CASEY, preacher

In all the historical past, nations have arisen and also fallen. Our Bible is the greatest history book of all books. The Apostle Paul speaks in **Romans 15:4** and in **I Corin**thians 10:11 saying: "For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning."
