## Friday, September 30, 2016 Scotty Winkler, 81

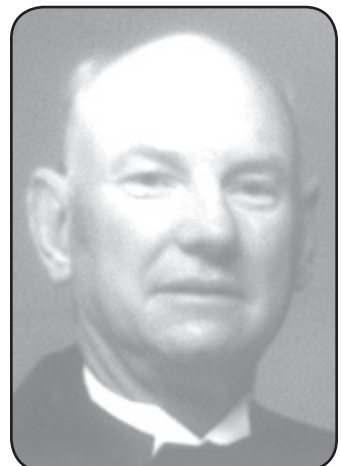
Scotty Winkler, age 81, widower of Bernice Robertson Winkler, passed away Friday, September 30, 2016, at his home after a long illness.
