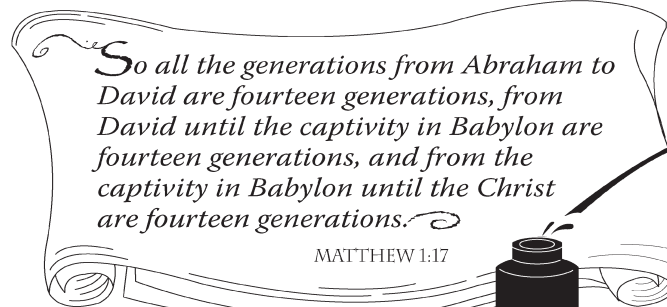
ardson, Estill County; one brother: Forrest Lutes, Estill County; four grandchildren, five great grandchildren and one great, great grandchild.

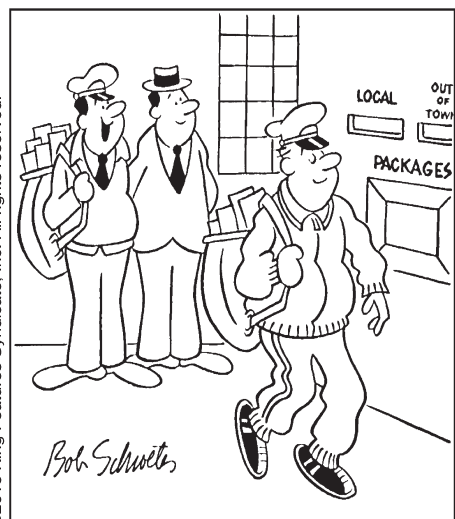
