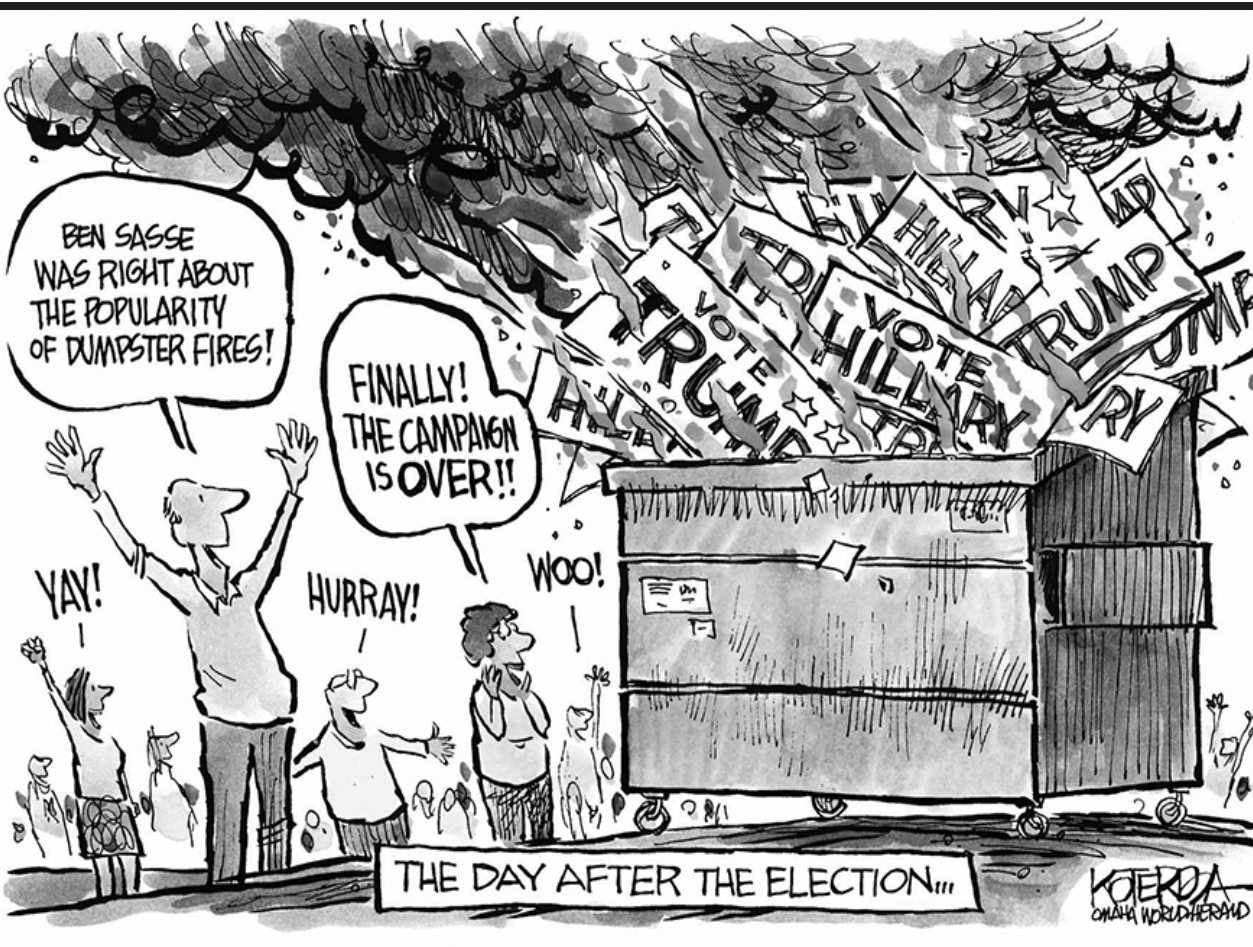

## Columbia Gas of Kentucky Presents Grant to Hospital

Columbia Gas of Kentucky made a special investment to aid in the fight against breast cancer in Eastern Kentucky with a \$10,000 grant from the NiSource Charitable Foundation that will help provide access to 3D mammography to women in Estill County and other nearby communities.

The grant to the Marcum & Wallace Memorial Hospital (MWMH) in Irvine, Kentucky will enable women in the rural communities served by the 25-bed critical access hospital to have access to the same state-of-the-art technology as women in urban areas. 3D mammography is able to detect breast cancer at its earliest possible stage. This technology is especially helpful in detecting cancer in women with very dense breast tissue, which hides or mimics breast cancer.

According to MWMH officials, a large percentage of women in the hospital's four-county service area report foregoing regular breast cancer screenings. Consequently, the breast cancer mortality rates for that area exceed state and national averages.

"Current statistics show that about one in eight women will have invasive breast cancer sometime during her life," said Arielle Estes, Director of Development for MWMH. "Providing 3D mammography screening close to home can have a significant impact on early detection and the overall survival rate for the women we serve."

The MWMH Foundation launched the campaign for 3D mammography a year ago and has raised
