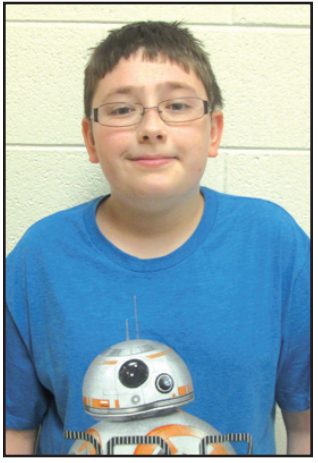


Estill County Middle School Students of the Week
