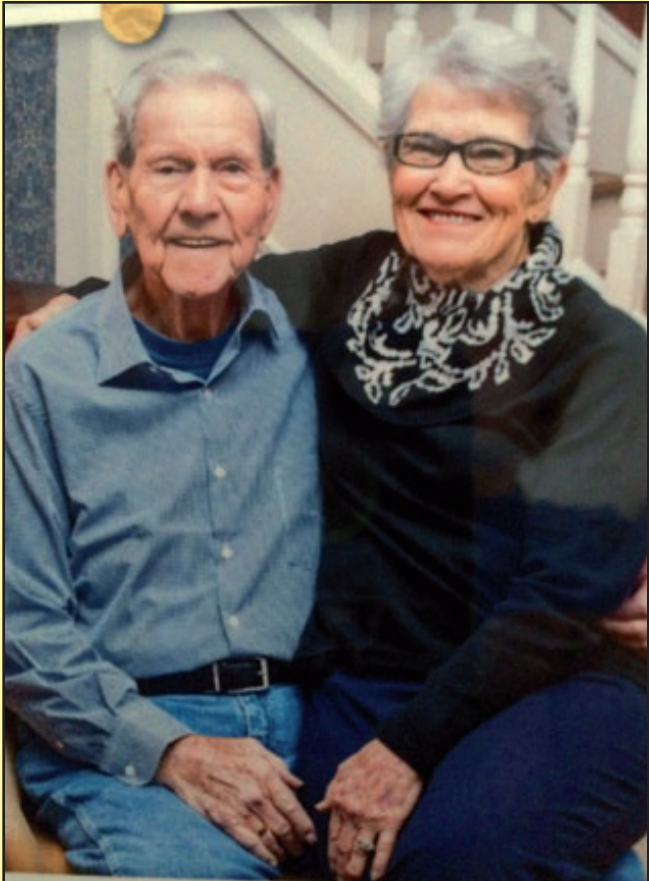
Irvine Woman Wins H&R Block's 1,000 Win \$1,000 Sweepstakes
