flower, never to fade or die; keep on giving beauty and joy and love, just like all you gave to us.

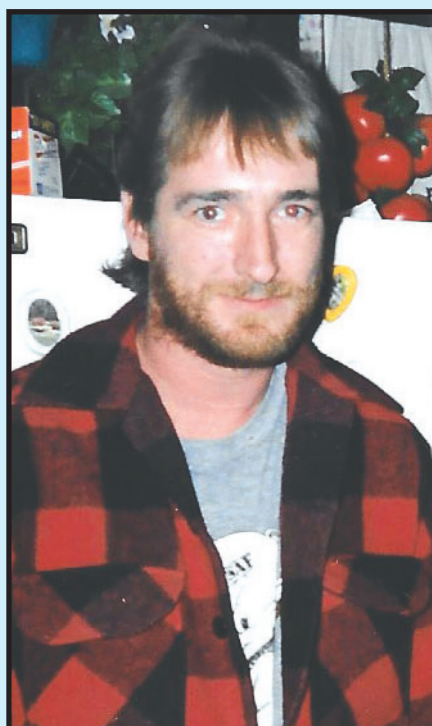
It will bloom in our hearts and live there in a special place forever. And all the love I had for you, just as you do for us, too.
