


Young caterpillars can be ing Bacillus thuringiensis varkurstaki. Some other insecticides include Sevin, Bonide Eight, Captain Jack's Deadbug Brew, Malathion, other products listing caterpillars on the label. Larvae within the tents are protected beneath the webbing and are more difficult to kill with an insecticide so treat the leaves on which they feed. Caution – be sure to follow the insecticide label instructions.


