### Elzie McIntosh, 69



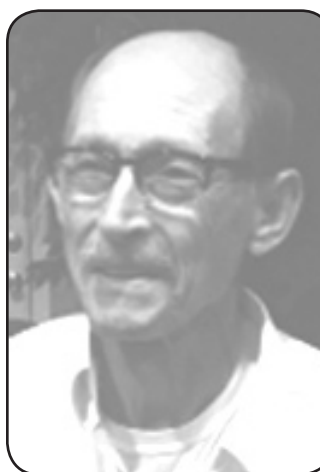
