

found in II Peter 2 written by Peter in the year 64AD to the Jews as well as the Gentiles. He already had recognized that during his short life many had entered into the field of prophecy claiming that they were also sent by God. Paul the apostle in Acts 20:17-31 warned the Christian elders from Ephesus that this false system was making some inroads into the church of Christ. And their motive there was the same as it is today: verse 33, "To draw away disciples after them." He finished his words unto them as a warning to be on guard as overseers to guard against this false effort. Now Peter in telling the church how this false teaching had gotten its foothold, "by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of." He said sadly: that many shall follow their evil ways, saying also that they would make merchandise out of people. This had its beginning early in the church even before Jerusalem was destroyed. In Acts 5:35-39 there are two men called Theudas and Judas who led several people away after their claiming to be led by God, but they were killed and the remainder dispersed. But even in Paul's day the Roman emperor was eyeballing the church with great suspicion. So a few years later they claimed that a Roman church overseen by the emperor was the only church that should be recognized, and so they warred and fought toe and toenail for several hundreds of years up to the invention of the printing press in very late 1589. Then men began to trail off into different groups with different names, different beliefs, and different teachings, all because they refused to agree upon the basic truths of the Bible. So today this availability to read the book of God has caused many to turn away from the inspired scriptures to form their own groups, commonly called denominationalism. These teachings not only lead men from the truth, but many more are following suit.

But in Noah's life (Genesis 6-7), God called Noah a preacher of righteousness. He acquired this name long before he was told to build the ark. Genesis 6:8-9 says he walked with God. Then being commanded to build this ark to save his family and the animals, he began by preaching and building. So he never stopped until he had finished this task. Then just as God said: "Here comes the flood," it destroyed all the unbelieving sinners who refused to hear the message of Noah's preaching.

In the same text he includes the people of Sodom and Gomorrah who were very ungodly people, but God was merciful by sending them a warning to repent, but they refused (Genesis 19) and they were destroyed. Peter is using this example to warn today's mankind, turn from false teachings, listen and obey only the truths truly found in the Bible so you will not suffer the destruction mentioned in **II Peter 3** when this earth and the things will suffer the vengeance of fire. So don't be one of the unstable and unlearned, heed God's word completely, then obey its precepts so you can escape all these destructions that will surely come. I hope you will obey our Lord, even today.
