
#### 5th & 8th Grade Students Learn About The Real World

The Reality Store is a financial simulation where 8th grade students from Estill County High School and 5th grade students from West Irvine Intermediate School choose careers and make decisions about their budgets and lifestyles. The activity is a fun and effective way for students to learn about personal accounting, financial responsibility and life choices, and interact with business people.

The project involves Estill County Family Resource and Youth Services Centers, Estill County Extension Office and about 30- to 40-plus local business and parent volunteers. Students receive "paychecks" and random information regarding how many children that they have. They also receive checkbooks and instructions on making purchases. Business volunteers, including Eastern Kentucky University Educational Talent Search Program, Hary Oil, Hardy Gas, Citizens Guaranty Bank, Marcum Wallace Hospital, Playtime Daycare, the Estill County Health Department, and Carhartt, staff stations around the gymnasium of Estill County Middle School.

Stations include taxes, financial institution, real estate, apartment rentals, apparel, car dealer, day care, gasoline, charities, entertainment, "fate," gasoline, government, grocery store, insurance, investments, household products, phone company, cable TV and utilities. Students visit the stations, write checks and balance their checkbooks. Upon
