#### Grape hyacinths start from small bulbs. Place them in groups of ten or more, with the bulbs twice as deep as they are tall and a couple of inches apart. They grow in sun or light shade.

Don't plant them where it's too wet or too dry. They spread very quickly and can be quite invasive; plant them where it is acceptable for them to spread freely. The flower spikes don't appear until mid-spring. There may be some variation in color, depending on which ones you plant, but smoky blue is the most common color. Once their leaves die off, you can cut them back. - Brenda Weaver
