ECMS SBDM Parent Nominations

Estill County High School will be accepting parent nominations for the ECMS Site Based Decision Making Council (SBDM) for the 2016-2017 school years. Nominations for SBDM will be made in the ECMS main office May 2nd thru 6th from 8:30 am until 3:00 pm.

Two parents will be elected to serve on the council and required to attend a SBDM Training before school begins. Estill County High School Election for SBDM council members will be held on May 10th and 11th.

Parents may vote in the ECMS main lobby from 8:30 am until 3:00 pm. Parents are eligible to nominate, run for election and vote only if they will have a student enrolled at Estill County High School for the 2016-2017 school year.

Parent Nominations for ECMS SBDM

Estill County Middle school will be taking nominations for the 2016-2017 school-based council - through April 29 in the school's office. Parents must have a child enrolled in either 6th, 7th, or 8th grade next school year in order to be eligible. Once nominations are compiled, the vote will take place May 3-9. Two seats will be filled by this process. The term is for one school year. The voting process will be conducted by the Youth Service Center adult advisory council members.
