## Teen is charged with multiple charges after a high speed chase

An 18 year old faces eight charges, including leaving the scene of an accident. Irvine Officer Sam Hensley said he observed a 2008 grey Ford at 4:53 a.m. Sunday traveling west at a high rate of speed near the intersection of Main Street and Chestnut Street. As the vehicle entered the Irvine bridge, Hensley said it swerved to the right to avoid hitting another vehicle in the rear end. He added the vehicle struck the walkway on the right side, causing minor damage to the concrete. Hensley said he activated the cruiser's lights and sirens, but the vehicle swerved left into the oncoming lane and the driver accelerated the vehicle. He said the vehicle reached speeds of up to 90 mph and moved across all three lanes of travel. He added the chase continued on Richmond Road with the Ford running through two red traffic lights. It then pulled into the parking lot at 1248 Richmond Road. Hensley said that McDonalds at 901 Richmond Road called and identified the driver and vehicle as having crashed into their patio and leaving the scene. The driver was identified as 18 year old Michael Lain Abner of N. Stacy lane, Irvine. He was charged with fleeing or evading police first degree, operating a motor vehicle under the influence of drugs or alcohol, first offense, operating on a suspended/revoked license, leaving scene of an accident, careless driving, possession of an open alcohol container in the vehicle, improper equipment, and wanton endangerment first degree (police officer) Abner was arraigned in Estill District Court on Monday, May 2. He pleaded not guilty to all charges. His bond was amended to \$2,500 cash or \$5,000 property. He was released that day on a \$2,500 cash bond. He is scheduled to return to district court for a preliminary hearing on May 23.

The tablet was valued at \$900 and the camera at \$675. Bail for Hatton was set at \$10,000 cash. • A damaged fence was reported April 28 to Deputy Daniel Smith by Sandra Holland of Dark Hollow Road. She told the deputy that a vehicle had backed into her fence. The report says that silver paint was left on the fence. The investigation is continuing.
