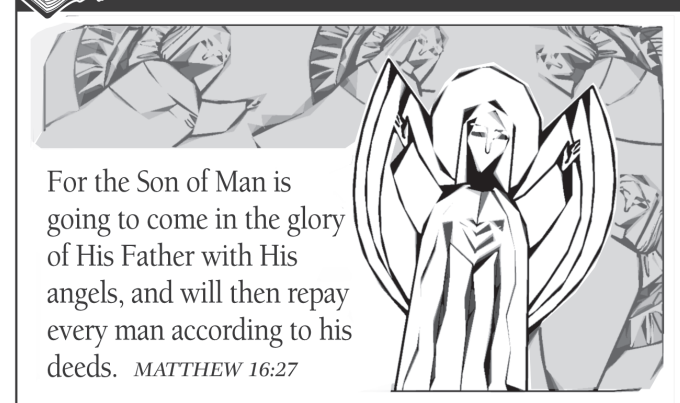
Mr. Noland is survived by his wife, Glynna Hays
