Potent fentanyl, mixed with heroin, drives 14.7 percent increase in fatal drug overdoses in Kentucky from 2014 to 2015

The office counted 1,248 from the 1,088 reported in in more than a third: 420, up from 121.

"Heroin was detected in 28 percent of cases, consistent with the previous year," the Justice and Pubpress release. "However, as a total, heroin-related deaths increased in 2015, largely because the drug is being laced with fentanyl."

"The introduction of illicit fentanyl into the heroin trade is producing devastating results," Van Ingram, director of the office, said in the release. "Whether it's manufactured to resemble heroin or a prescription pill, already dangerous situation worse."
