2016 Estill County 4-H Summer Camp

Estill County 4-H members attended 4-H camp June 6th – 10th at J.M. Feltner 4-H Camp in London, Kentucky. (See photo on Page 15, at right).

In total, 56 campers were able to attend this year along with 10 adult and teen counselors. While we are very proud of how our camping program has grown, this year has been exceptional.

At Camp Feltner, campers chose four classes to attend every morning. Twenty-four different classes ranged from archery and riflery to swimming and photography. The campers were also divided up by cabins into teams that they remained on all week. Throughout the week there were several different team events including a scavenger hunt, gold rush, and a mega relay where the teams could compete.

Camp is a unique experience in itself. For many campers, this is the first time that they have stayed away from home. This gives them the opportunity to branch out and meet people and do activities that they otherwise may not have been given. This is also a chance for them to be responsible for themselves. In the mornings, all cabins must be cleaned and swept and all beds must be made. The cleanest cabins were given an award, "the golden broom". Team building and working with others is also a valuable skill learned at camp. Campers must learn to work with those in their classes and on their teams to succeed in the competitions and in their classes.


