Estill County 4-H members attended 4-H camp June 6th – 10th at J.M. Feltner 4-H Camp in London, Kentucky. (See photo on Page 15, at right).

In total, 56 campers were able to attend this year along with 10 adult and teen counselors. While we are very proud of how our camping program has grown, this year has been exceptional.

At Camp Feltner, campers chose four classes to attend every morning. Twenty-four different classes ranged from archery and riflery to swimming and photography. 


