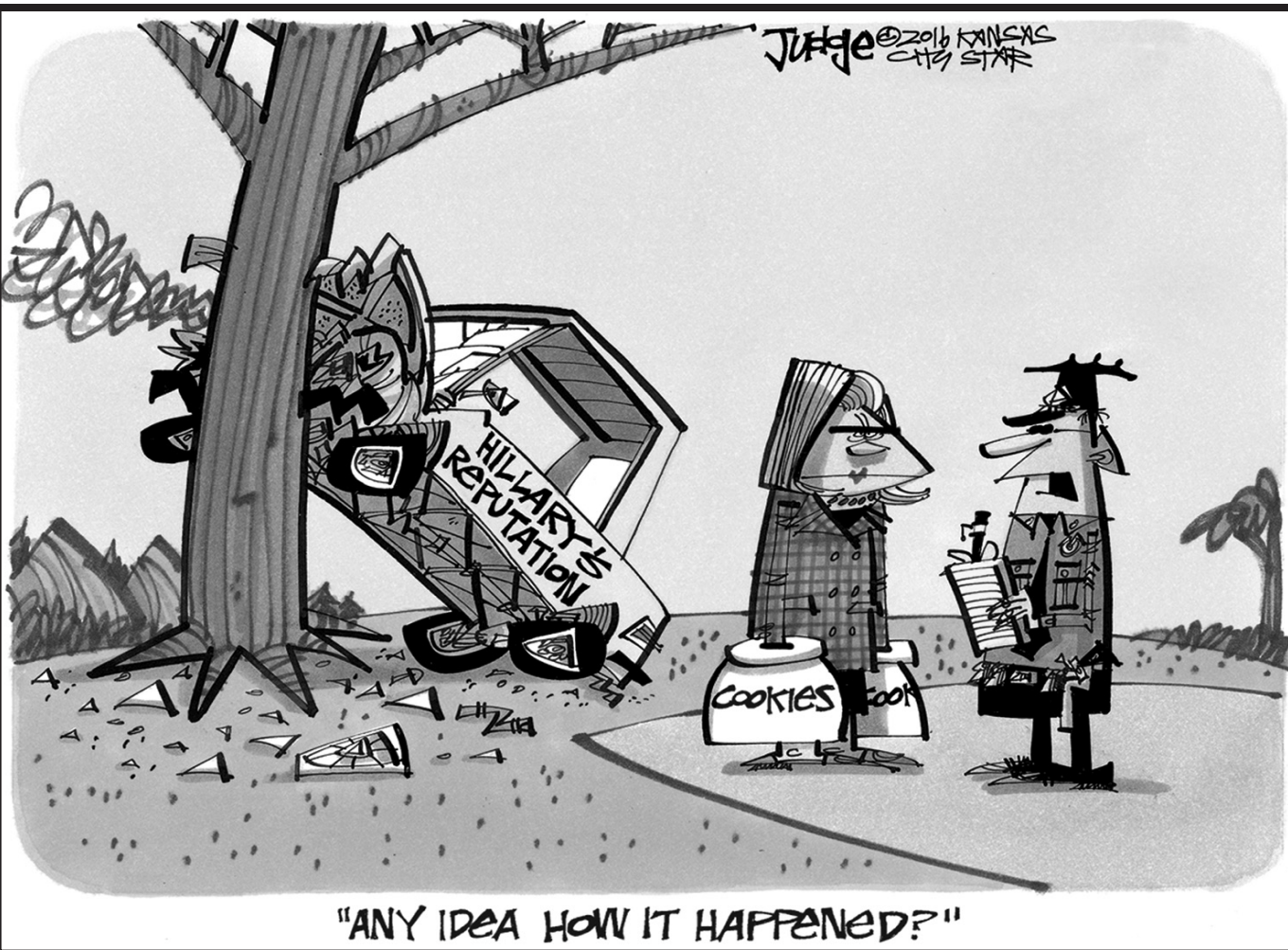
"Uh-oh," says his caddie to one of his playing partners, "There goes a club in the lake."
