Barbed mouthparts are inserted into the skin and a cement is secreted to hold ticks in place while they engorge, a process that can take from 2 hours to 7 days; then they drop from the host. Ticks inject an anesthetic material that makes the actual bite painless. However, the bite site may be red and painful for 1 to 2 weeks after the tick has fed.

Rock gardens, wildflower gardens or herb gardens that get Goldenrod full sun and have well-drained soil suit this plant very well. Mature goldenrod plants will be tall, so they need an area that is sheltered from the wind if possible. If not, they may need staking.
