Rondell Lee Patrick, 53

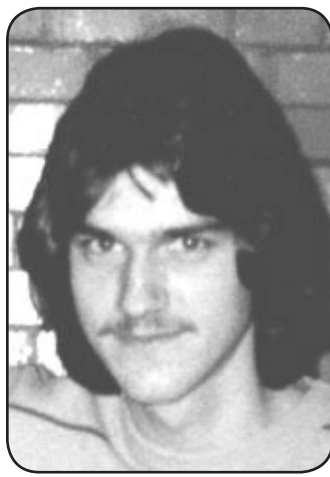
