

Four From Estill Among 32 ETS Students Traveling To Chicago

Participants in Eastern Kentucky University's Educational Talent Search (ETS) Program had the opportunity to take a four-day trip to Chicago, IL, June 27-30, 2016 at no cost to them. Participants were required to have at least a 2.5 grade point average, no school conduct issues, no more than 6 unexcused school absences, and active participation in the ETS Program during the academic year. Those meeting eligibility were then accepted based on the date of their trip registration. With over 50 registrations, we were able to take 32 participants to the Windy City.

The group traveled via Miller Transportation Motorcoach and arrived in Chicago Monday afternoon, June 27, 2016. After a tour of the city which included Millennium Park, Buckingham Fountain, the Loop, Lake Shore Drive, Cloud Gate (the Bean) and Pritzker Pavilion the group was ready for dinner at Hard Rock Café. Participants enjoyed a little stage entertainment from our very own students, and later got to view the city from atop of "360" the John Hancock Building. The evening allowed the Talent Search Scholars to settle in at the Holiday Inn Express & Suites in Rosemont, IL (outside of Chicago), and to have some social time at the

pool. The following days were packed with college tours at the University of Illinois-Chicago and DePaul University, museum visits at the Shedd Aquarium, Field Museum of Natural History, and the Museum of Science and Industry. Other historical and cultural events included time at the Navy Pier, dinner at Bubba Gump Shrimp Company, a 75 minute cruise on Lake Michigan and the Chicago River through the middle of Chicago architect, aboard the Seadog Cruiser. Our last night in Chicago was enjoyed by all as we had a dinner show at the Tommy Gun's Garage & Dinner

Theatre. Everyone arrived home on Thursday evening, June 30th, very tired, yet with new friends, new experiences, and lots of stories of their adventure to Chicago. The Educational Talent Search (ETS) TRIO Program, funded by the U.S. Department of Education, has hundreds of programs throughout the nation; eleven of which are located in Kentucky. Eastern Kentucky University has been a host institution for Talent Search for over 30 years, and currently serves 765 middle & high school students in the following Kentucky counties: Estill, Garrard, Jackson, Lee, Lincoln, and northern Madison.

ETS assists individuals who have the interest and ability to succeed in higher education. The program provides academic enhancement, personal development skills, college, career, and financial aid information, test preparation, college and career site visits, cultural activities, scholarship resources, assistance with college, financial aid, and scholarship applications, summer camp and more. All activities are FREE. There is an on-going application process until all vacancies are filled. Applications are distributed at the 6th grade in the first day take home packet, during school orientation and open

house, and during recruitment events at the middle school and high school. Farmers Market Week Is August 7-13

Some of Kentucky's approximately 160 farmers' markets will be celebrating National Farmers' Market Week Aug. 7-13 with special events, Agriculture Commissioner Ryan Quarles said.

"Farmers' markets give consumers the chance to buy farm-fresh fruits and vegetables as well as meats, bread, sauces, cut flowers, crafts, and many other farm products," Commissioner Quarles said. "They also provide an opportunity for shoppers to meet the people who produced the food. And they generate economic activity in their local communities. I encourage everyone to visit your local farmers' market."

If you want to buy locally grown vegetables and other locally produced items, the Estill County Farmer's Market is open Friday's 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Estill County fairgrounds on South Irvine Road. On the second Tuesdays of each month,

the market is open 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Estill County Extension Service off Stacy Lane Road.

Many markets offer cooking demonstrations, sampling, door prizes and other events to commemorate the week, said Sharon Spencer, the Kentucky Department of Agriculture's farmers' market specialist.

Bluegrass Farmers' Market in Lexington will have three special education centers set up on master gardeners, Kentucky garden clubs, and the Monarch Butterfly Garden Initiative on Saturday, Aug. 13. The market is giving away 250 pumpkin scoops embossed with the Kentucky Proud logo at both Saturday market sites.

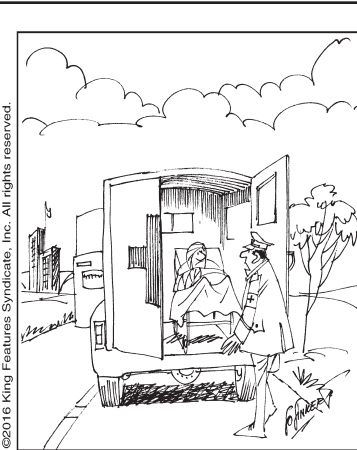

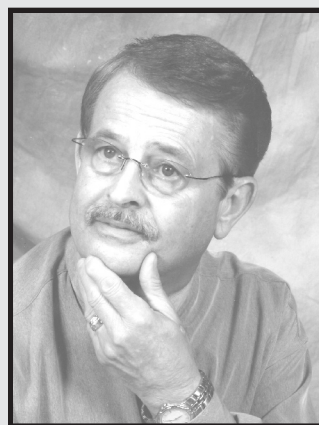
