

Engineers Sink Powell County, 48-26

The Estill County Engineers would take the short trip to Stanton to take on rival Powell County in a district matchup on Friday night.

Estill would open up a tight game with 19 points in the fourth quarter on their way to a 48-26 victory. With the win, the 'Neers would stay atop the district with a 2-0 record and run their season record to 4 wins and 2 losses.
