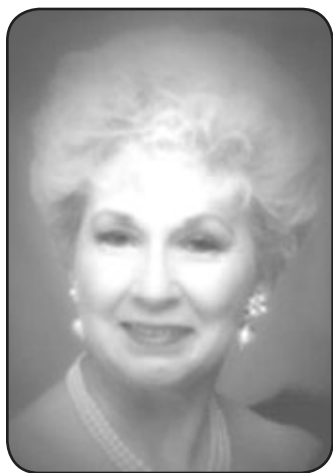

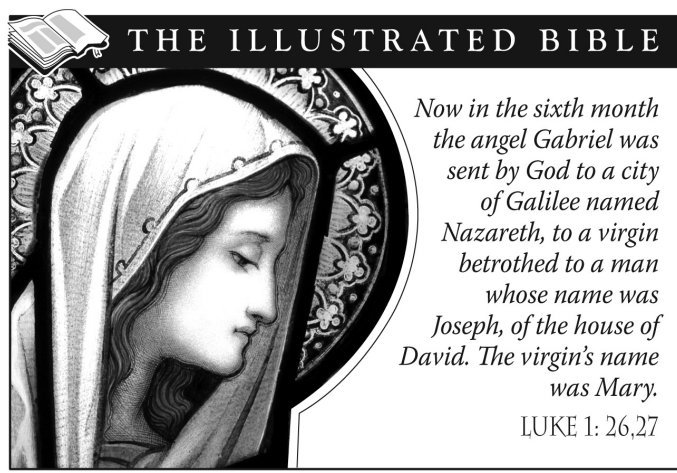

Mr. Reeves is survived by one sister, Faye Spicer, Cart-

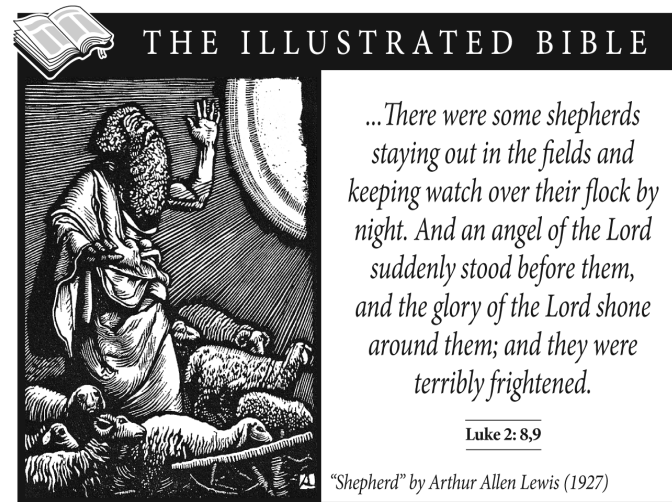
ersville, Georgia; one brother, Freddie Reeves (Edna), Estill County; and a host of nieces and nephews.
