## **A Bad Witness**

Romans 2:24, "For the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written."

This was said to King David by Nathan the prophet in **2 Samuel** 12:14. It happened because of David's sin with Bathsheba. David had let his desires rule instead of him keeping God's law. The result was adultery, abuse of his power, and murder. Sins cannot be hid for long and when those who are supposed to be men of God do such things people belittle not only the man, but the way of God.

In our day the same holds true. When a Christian, or someone who is thought to be a Christian, sins, people mock the church. They figure that there is nothing to Christianity if a believer does things that an unbeliever does. Even so, there is a difference between a person failing in a moment of weakness and the person who sins by choice. Any, and all of us, err at times, but a hypocrite makes a habit of sinning while claiming to be a follower of Jesus.

For example a person who says that he believes and lives for the Lord, but does not live for anyone but himself is a hypocrite. So many claim to be following Jesus but care little for his words. This happened in the time that Jesus walked the earth to the extent that he asked, "And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?" Luke 6:46. There is no answer that a person can give to excuse such behavior. People who do not follow, nor try to obey, the Lord may be sinners, but they are not stupid. They know that a Christian is supposed to live a better life than the lost person.
