## Komen Grant to fund mammograms at M&W

Marcum & Wallace Memorial Hospital (MWMH) in Irvine has been awarded funding from the Lexington Affiliate of Susan G. Komen Kentucky to help fund breast cancer screenings for underserved and underinsured patients. MWMH has received nearly \$139,000 over the last six years from Komen Kentucky.

"We are committed to breaking down barriers for people who need access to healthcare," said Susan Starling, MWMH President & CEO. "We do not want anyone in our community to go without regular mammograms because of costs associated with the exam."

The Komen grant will help patients who do not have health insurance, are under-insured or have a high deductible and cannot afford a mammogram. This grant will assist women and

men with screening and diagnostic mammograms.

The American Cancer Society recommends that women, age 40 and older, have an annual mammogram. Statistics show that one in every eight women will be diagnosed with breast cancer during her lifetime. Women with a family history of breast cancer should speak with their healthcare provider about the appropriate age to get their first mammogram. Mammograms are the best way to diagnose breast cancer in the early stages when it is often more easily treated.
