Estill students at selected to attend the 2017 Rogers Explorers program

Estill County Middle School students Rayleigh Jones and Peyton Mize have been selected to attend The Center for Rural Development's 2017 Rogers Explorers youth leadership program. Rogers Explorers is open to eighth-grade students in Southern and Eastern Kentucky who have a strong interest in developing their skills in leadership, technology, math, science, and community service. Two hundred and twelve students—the largest class ever—will converge on the campuses of seven Kentucky colleges and universities this summer for the Rogers Explorers program. "Rogers Explorers gives students a one-of-a-kind learning experience to explore possible career paths in the fields of math, science, and technology," said Delaney Stephens, community liaison and youth programs coordinator for The Center. "The program also encourages creative thinking and teamwork and builds leadership skills as the region's next generation of leaders and entrepreneurs." Rogers Explorers is presented by The Center for Rural Development in partnership with Lindsey Wilson College, University of the Cumberlands, Eastern Kentucky University, Morehead State University, Asbury University, the University of Pikeville, and the newest host site, Union College. Students spend three days and two nights on one of these leading Kentucky college campuses, where experts guide them through hands-on assignments, all of which encourages participants to build their math, science, and technology skills. The program is provided tuition-free to eligible students within The Center's 45-county primary service area. Jones is the daughter of Dusty and Tom Jones of Irvine. "Say On, Say On!" by BOB CASEY, preacher Cornerstone Church of Christ 70 Bond Street at Camp Avenue in West Irvine

The title of this article is taken from the words of a faithful, elderly sister-in-the-Lord. When myself, or other preachers, would preach a strong message straight from the pages of the Bible, she was prompted to use this term, "Say on, say on." She was well qualified to say this because she read the Bible every day of her life. And, when a preacher would preach a sermon that was not very informing about the context, she would say, "You need to did a little deeper into the well, son!" And this was done in a loving and concerned attitude during the exiting of the building after worship was over. She once told me several years before her passing; she said, "The Lord is going to let me live to see a hundred, because I have asked him and I know he will do it." She lived to be 101; I know, because I spoke at her eulogy. What a wonderful world we would have if more people were liken unto her.

She knew that only the Word was fitly and strongly preached, no one would be saved otherwise. So, today, I will once again remind all of us, unless we hear all the truth upon any subject in the Bible, we will end up on the short end of the information that we need in order to be saved from our sins; how to rightly worship the Lord as he has all the information that we will ever need on any subject that can be found in the Bible. But, how long has it been since you

heard a message about the real, terrible place called Hell or Lake of Fire, awaiting the unbelievers, or how long has it been since you heard a complete sermon on The Plan of Salvation? And, how long has it been since you heard from the Bible that the church of the Lord partakes of the Lord's Supper as the Word teaches? One more thing, how long has it been since you heard a sermon concerning our giving of our funds to the Lord's work? I know that most of you have it, to give a tithe of 10%. How long has it been since you heard someone read from the Law of Christ that says to give as you have been prospered (Read 1 Corinthians 16:12 to see if it is there.) Sadly, most people will not even give a tenth. I remind all of us that we are not living under the Old Testament today, but under the Law of Christ. Just a few minutes of our time reading from Hebrews, chapters 8-10, will straighten out your minds concerning this.

There is much confusion going related to all these things. So, by just spending some time reading from the Holy Book will help you to see what the truth really is. Do you want to go to Heaven? If so, it is imperative that you know the truth and obey it. Notice in 1 Timothy 4:16, "Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee." So, we must all read the Bible and then obey its contents. So, I will close this way, "Say on, say on!"
