# JEC, CoBank donation helps feed the hungry

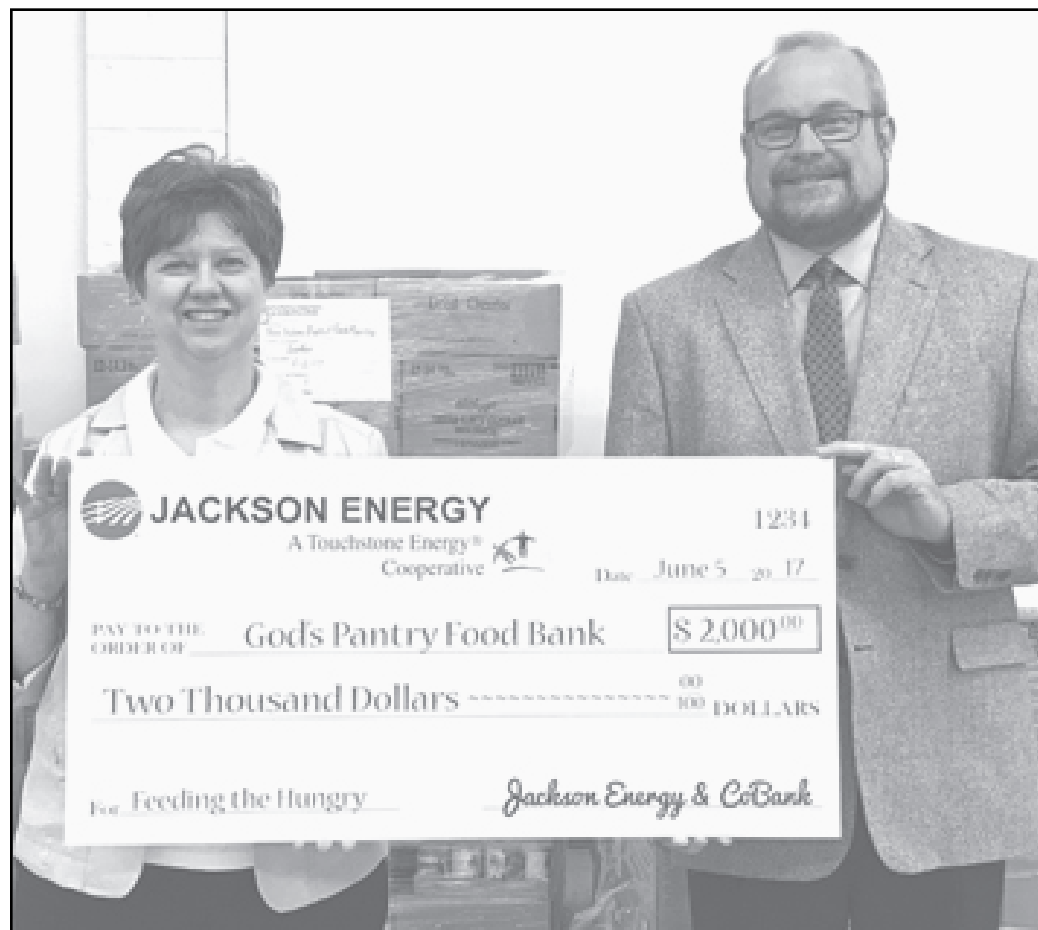

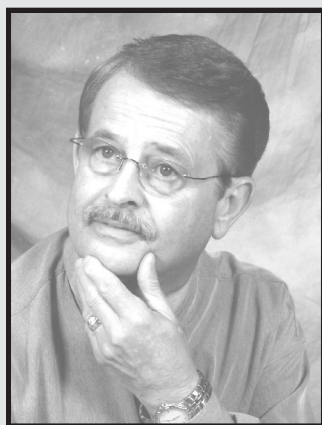
