Working Righteousness by BOB CASEY, preacher

Cornerstone Church of Christ

In Acts 10:34-35, Peter, being sent by the Holy Spirit, had gone and entered into the house of a Gentile by the name of Cornelius, a centurion soldier of the Roman Army. But, he was under the influence of the religion of the Jews. He had become devout in his commandment keeping. He was an alms giver to the poor, prayed daily, feared God, had a good report among all them that knew him. So, he was faithful unto God by keeping the Old Testament Law of Moses. And in **verse 31**, the angel of Lord said, "Cornelius, thy prayer is heard, and thine alms are had in remembrance in the sight of God." Peter, being pre-informed about this man, began to preach unto him about Jesus Christ. Most likely, Cornelius had picked up bits and pieces concerning the Christ, so he was very desirous to know all about him. Then, Peter began to preach the words that would fulfill the mind and desire of Cornelius. He must have preached about the beginnings of our Lord and about his baptism in the River of Jordan and about his work among men, all about the miracles he did to substantiate him as the son of God. Then, how he was rejected, slain by crucifixion but raised from the dead the third day.

On this day in the household of Cornelius, God had given him the answer to his prayers, saying, whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins. And to validate the message, God sent the Holy Spirit upon them that heard the word. Then Peter said, can any man forbid water (baptism) that these should not

be baptized which have received the Holy Spirit as well as we (the Apostles) and he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord.

Notice that this type of meeting only happens twice in the Holy scriptures. First upon the day of Pentecost in Acts 2 and here in Acts 10. My question to anyone who believes that this takes precedence over the commands of Christ to hear him, believe in him, to repent of all sins, to confess his name before men, and to be baptized for the remission of sins. Does what happens in the household of Cornelius overshadow all that Jesus had done and said beforehand? Notice that Cornelius was working righteousness under the Law of Moses. But, now, after he heard the word, read for validation the words spoken in Acts 11:14 which says that Peter was sent to him, telling him words whereby thou and all thy house shall be saved.

So, his works of righteousness under Moses' Law could not save him, but now, having a more perfect knowledge about God and Christ, he worked the law of righteousness according to the commands of Christ Jesus. So, today, I ask what law did you follow if you claim salvation? The same requirements concerning the old law is fulfilled in the Law of Christ; to hear, to obey Christ who fulfilled and done away the Old Testament law. Take a minute to read the 13 verses of Hebrews 8. See if I tell the truth. So, in closing, let me carefully say this, salvation cannot be found in the keeping of the Old Law but by what Cornelius had heard and obeyed in the Law of Christ.

There was a time on earth when there were no nations or governments. People did as they pleased. As a result, God's creation - the human race - sank into disgraceful depths of despair. God wanted to solve the problem so He covered the earth with a flood in judgment. Then He put government in the world to restrain wickedness. That first government came from God and every government ever since, has come from God.

Why? Because no one has any authority except from God. Whether those who govern us are good or bad, right or wrong, gracious or greedy - they are there because God put them there. Some use their power to do God's

will. Others use their power in an attempt to go against God's will. Whoever serves the people as leaders serve as He pleases with His permission.

Yet, it follows that those who refuse to obey the laws of God will ultimately be punished for their disobedience. Perhaps they will get away with it here, but certainly not in the "hereafter."

"God presides in the great assembly," wrote Asaph, the author of Psalm 82. And he concluded, "He gives judgment among the 'gods'." In other words, if those whom God has placed in positions of leadership as rulers or judges do not rule with God's laws and commandments as their guide they will face His judgment.

Not long ago, one ruler who was dying cried out, "Now I must face the Judge. This is what disturbs me." We, too, must face this Judge. What will we face on that day?
