<u>Luke 14:18-20</u>, "And they all with one consent began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused. And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused. And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come."

One thing that most people do when faced with something that they don't wish to explain, or to face, is to make an excuse. Someone said that an excuse is what a person makes when they don't have a reason. Or a reason that they don't want to give. I'm afraid that all of us have given some excuse at some time in our lives. Maybe it was for something that we did, or an excuse for something that we were supposed to do, but didn't.
