Fiscal Court amends sick leave policy

The Estill Fiscal Court also met Friday to give final approval to their budget which took effect on July 1.

The court also amended the county's personnel policy on sick leave and use of cell phones.

They voted to allow county employees to incur an unlimited number of sick days and be compensated for them when they leave the county

Employees will also be allowed to donate up to 40 hours of their accumulated sick time to a county em-

The previous policy allowed for an employee to donate their accumulated sick time to another employee when they leave.

Employees will only be allowed to use cell phones and electronic devices while they are on break or on county business.
