

8th Grade Lady Engineers open season with win over Powell Co.

One of the winningest groups of players in Estill County Middle School history started off their season with a bumpy win over the Powell County Lady Pirates on Monday night at Estill.

This group started off as the Lady Patriots but became the Lady Engineers and continued their winning ways into the 7th grade.

Now as 8th graders, this team is expected to be a contender in both the conference and in 56th District play.

Estill opened up 7-0 against the Lady Pirates, starting with a shot by Mariah Riddell. But Powell finally scored and got back

into the game to trail 9-4 at the end of the first quarter. They pulled within 4 by halftime, 17-13.

The Lady Engineers had a great third quarter and went up by 10 at the end, 27-17 which pretty much put the game away.

But the Lady Pirates never stopped until the buzzer and outscored Estill 9-6 in the 4th to fall 33-26.

Mia Hale, who has scored more than 1,000 points for Estill, put in 12 to lead the Lady Engineers. Emma Winkle, who works hard the entire game, scored 7.

Hannah Baker, put in 6, and Riddell and Macy Reed put in 4 each.

Despite the win, Estill shot poorly from the floor and the charity stripe. The Lady Engineers hit only 4 of 18 free throw attempts, including 12 attempts in the final quarter. Powell didn't

shoot free throws well either, hitting only 2 of 11.

Ruth Hughes remains as coach of the 8th grade despite being named as the head coach of the ECHS Lady Engineers.

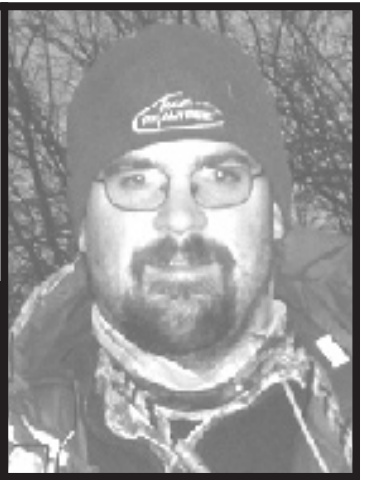

Exhaust Filter Full

I've got a Dodge 3500 Cummins Diesel truck. I love my Dodge. It has 232,000 miles and not had very much trouble with it. Last week I was driving on 52 when a warning light comes on that says exhaust filter 80% full. Then it went to 90%. After 90% it said regeneration in process. Then regeneration stopped and it said exhaust filter full power loss. I managed to make it home running 30 mph.

Once I got home I started Googling to find the fix. I tried the cheap fixes with no luck. So that meant take it to the shop. The answer I got was \$4000 to fix or \$2000 to delete exhaust filter. My options were pricey!

A little background on regeneration and exhaust filters. Apparently a diesel will regenerate which causes the filter to be blown out. When the filter gets clogged up with soot the truck lets you know. The regeneration blows all the nasty out.

I risked a drive after being told my truck needed work and the possibility of it shutting down. It seemed to be running better so I drove on to Lexington with

a trailer in tow. I loaded the trailer up and had to go to dump it.

On my way to dump brush and dirt on the trailer I said a little prayer. I said, Lord I could use some help with the truck. I looked down and the exhaust filter said 90% then 80% then 70% full. It said regeneration in process. The black smoke rolled out. Finally it said regeneration finished. My truck was to full power.

I immediately looked up regeneration and it means to be made new. Then I thought to myself THANKS LORD for giving my column this week and THANKS for the immediate answered prayer.

If we you don't know Jesus you walk around filled with soot. Once you know Jesus there is a regeneration. You're made new. Jesus died on the cross to take the soot out of us. He cleans out all the darkness.
