Mr. Luster was preceded in death by his first wife, Patsy Hardy Luster.

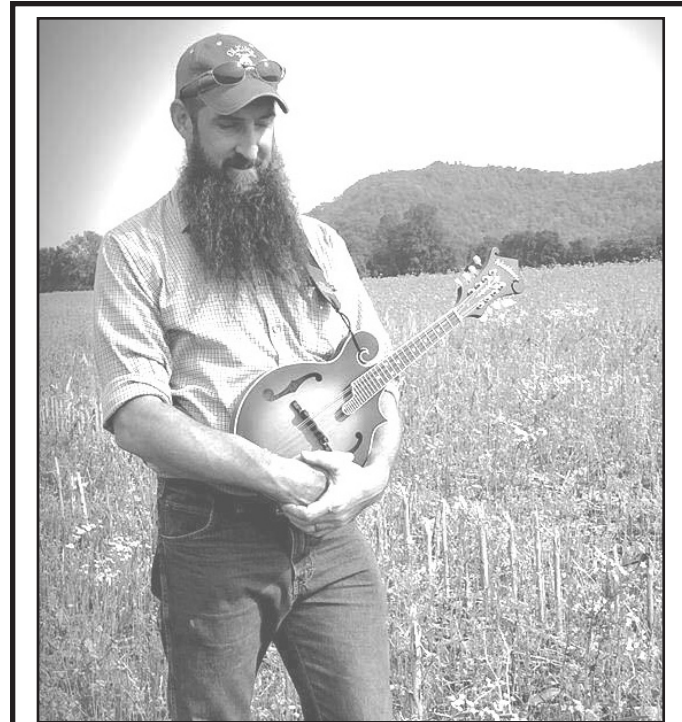
