Fire, The Very Thought of It

Did you know that it is against the law to yell, "Fire, Fire," in a crowded room when there is none to be found? All men generally think of fire as something that is to be avoided at all cost. So, we fear having to deal with the possibility of fire. Most have smoke detectors to awaken or alarm people that the possibility of fire is imminent. So, we all are aware that uncontrolled fire is something to despise.

But enough of this. Are you aware that God has chosen fire to reduce, burn up and do away with the present world as we know it? Fire is a very large subject matter in the New Testament; so, I will only be using a few verses to establish some very important facts.

A very alarming passage of Scripture is located in Matthew 13:39-51. Here in this passage, our Lord is talking about a day where he will purge the church of all those offenders of His truths which do lawless things. Then, he will also use his holy angels in this effort to sever the wicked from among the just and shall cast the offenders into a furnace of fire. Also, in Matthew 7:13-14, our Lord encourages men to "enter ye in at the strait gate" which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it. Here he says that "wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat". Matthew 5:8 and Mark 9:43 says that there is a fire awaiting that is everlasting and will never be quenched or satisfied.

Then in 2 Thessalonians 1:6-9, it says that this

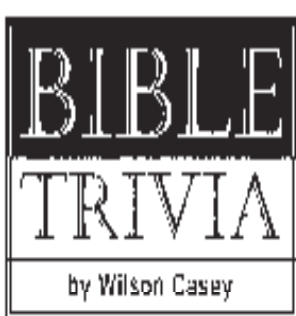
fire is a fire of vengeance upon all whom will never reverence nor obey the Lord Jesus.

I ask, do you know when this fire will be revealed? Yes, we do! in 2 Peter 3:17, he wrote "But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store (presently), reserved (awaiting) unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition (the loss of one's soul, never to go to Heaven) of ungodly men." Also, Jude 7, calls this fire eternal.

Notice in Revelations 20:10-15, gives us a picture of the Judgment and the Lake of Fire, called a place of torment, day and night, forever. Also, everyone's name not found in the Book of Life were cast into this Lake of Fire. Then in Revelations 21:8, gives the verdict of guilt upon the "the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death."

With all this and much more being written, concerning eternal fire to be the final dwelling place of all disobedient mankind, why would anyone in their right mind choose to go there? Sadly, many will fail to make the good choice to prepare themselves against this day, simply by procrastinating or putting off that which they aimed to do. Then, suddenly, deaths may come unexpectedly or the Lord could return and catch you unprepared. How awful to put off the best of good intentions and lose your own souls because you did so. If that comes upon you, Dear Friend, it will be no one's fault but yours. Don't do it, is our shout to you today. Fire, fire! Don't go there. You can avoid it by simply obeying the Lord today. Come, visit with us, we will take an open Bible and read the clear directions that can lead you to eternal security. Attend with us this next Lord's Day.

We never think of repentance as a false repentance. Believe it or not, a false repentance is motivated by worldly sorrow. It is a sorrow over wrongs that have been committed against other people; such as your wife, husband, mother, dad or whomever. The repentant person, with only worldly sorrow, may weep profusely over his transgressions and the hurt he has caused his loved ones. But his sorrow is founded up on worldly considerations. The sorrow of this world is full of tears of repentance, but not toward God.

False repentance is readily seen in the life of a drunkard, who squanders his paycheck on drink when he comes home to a hungry family and sees the shame and suffering he is causing by his evil deeds. He confesses his fault to his wife, with copious tears; however, soon he repeats his same shameful acts. What is his problem? He is motivated only by the sorrow of this world and has not changed his attitude toward his sins. He has never come to realize that he is first and foremost a transgressor against the laws of God.

True repentance must be based up on a knowledge of transgression against God. A man must understand through the word of God, that his simple life makes him an enemy of God. He must not only confess his sins, but he must also forsake them.

2 Corinthians 4:3-4: "But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them."

"Wow!" said an associate as a group of us left a restaurant after a dinner meeting. "That was a really good meal!"

"Good?" questioned another. "What do you mean good? That's one of the worst meals I've ever paid for. It was horrible!"

"Not so fast," said another. "Part of it was really bad and part was fairly good. At least, that's my opinion."

"Good" is in the eye of the beholder. You and I might experience the same event together - as the meal mentioned above - but have entirely different opinions about it. But when the author of Psalm 100 was ending his thoughts about God, he said, "For the Lord is good and His

Years ago when the Anglo-Saxons were converted to Christ they searched for a word in their language that they could all agree upon that expressed the character of the divine Being of the Bible.

They described stories of His faithfulness, His grace, His holiness, His mercy, His power, His love, His salvation and asked, "What one word will express all of these words?" After a discussion they all agreed: "The good!" And "good" is the old English word for "God."

When we look at the "big picture" of all that God has done for us, to us and in us, it is certainly appropriate for us to describe Him, as they did, as "The Good."
