Homecoming at Ivory Hill Baptist

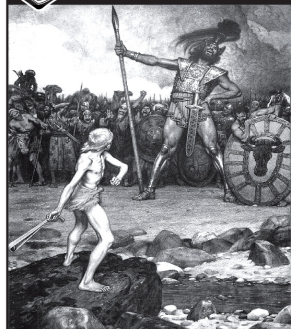

John wrote that Christ's primary purpose in coming to this world was to take away our sins. "And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin." (1 John 3:5)

We were by nature the 'children of wrath.' "Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others." (Ephesians 2:3)

Our deprived nature craved that which was evil, urged us to do wrong, and conquered our higher sense of right. We succumbed to the power of sin; we know better but we yielded to the emotion of sin. With our minds we sought to do good but out of our base nature emerges the evil impulses that corrupted our goodness.
