FRANKFORT, Ky. - The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet announced today that \$76,200 in Rural Secondary Road Aid emergency funds will be used for slip or slide repairs in Estill County. Repairs will be made to KY 3325 (Opossum Run Road) near milepoint 2.9.

"The Bevin administration is committed to the Cabinet's mission of providing a safe, reliable transportation network for all Kentuckians," said KYTC Secretary Greg Thomas. "These emergency funds will help repair and restore damaged infrastructure throughout this community."

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet is responsible for administering the work.
