Partaking of the Bread of Life

In the Gospel of John, 6:30-35, it is written, "They said therefore unto him, What sign shewest thou then, that we may see, and believe thee? what dost thou work? Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, He gave them bread from heaven to eat."

"Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world."

"Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread."

"And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst."

It would exhaust the entire contents of this paper to make comments regarding this all-important teaching of our Lord's things that could be said, along with all the related scriptures, so we will just use a few in an attempt to try to get out readers involved in the reading of the 6th Chapter of John.

If you will notice within this chapter, there are several statements made by Jesus regarding this subject. First, he says "I am the bread of life." He also says, "I am the living bread which came down from heaven." Then he says in Verse 48, "I am that bread of life." Also he says in Verse 51, "I am the living bread." Then he adds in Verse 58, that "he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever." So, how can only serious Bible readers miss the all-important facts of these teachings of our Lord?

Back in Verse 26, Jesus says, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were

filled." How sad this was, but even today, most of the people in this present world are still like-minded, caring more for food, clothing, shelter, autos and other things that pertain to man's physical needs and disregarding the most important thing and this is, feeding one's spiritual man upon Godly things. Then Jesus admonishes them and us as well in John 6:27, saying, "Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed."

In the way of personal recollections, I have in the past, and presently, know of people who professed to be Christians who are feeding themselves upon a diet of working on the Lord's Day, seeking selfish pleasures during vacation, and forsaking the meeting with the Lord and his Saints. I ask, does you Lord allow us a time of regeneration brought about by some leisure time? Yes, he does. It is written in Mark 6:31, where Jesus said, "Come ye yourselves apart into a desert place, and rest a while: for there were many coming and going, and they had no leisure so much as to eat." So, then, our Lord does allow time for physical refreshing of one's self, but not at the expense of missing the Lord's Day Assembly!

We are fully instructed upon the Lord's Day Communion as we eat of the loaf and drink of the fruit of the vine, these represent the sufferings of our Lord for us. But, this you cannot do, if you fail to meet with the Church each Lord's Day. How often, you say? The best of examples are to be found in Acts 20:1-7 that says, "upon the first day of the week." Just like 1 Corinthians 16:1-2 says, "Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store." Bible readers, read carefully, for some people do not believe this.

"On the first day of each month I carefully walk through every room in my home to make certain that there is nothing that would embarrass Jesus if He were to visit our family," said my friend. "If there is anything anywhere that is not appropriate for His eyes, it certainly is wrong for me to gaze upon it. If there are magazines or books or newspapers that have vile or unclean photos or stories I throw them away immediately. And because of the influence of television - even the news or children's stories or cartoons, we got rid of our television. And many would think we were wise. But when I talk to "them" about Jesus, many of them think I'm weird even without having that 'stuff' corrupt my mind and the minds of my children."

His statements brought back childhood memories of my home in Lorain, Ohio. His attitude was the same as my mother's. I can hear an echo of her voice today: "We're not going to allow Satan to live in this house," she said often. In every room there was an open Bible - readily visible for anyone to see. The walls had pictures of Bible stories and scenes of the way people lived in the days of Jesus. Wherever guests looked, they were reminded of something that had to do with the story of salvation. Of course, we also had family photos. But they were pictures of activities that were related to church events or pictures of us "kids" standing next to missionaries or evangelists.

"Home is where the heart is," someone once said. And if the "heart" belongs to Jesus He will be very visible.

Acts 2:36-39: "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call."

Assembled in an upper room in Jerusalem were approximately 120 disciples who had met in prayer and praise to wait the coming of the Holy Ghost. The stage had been set 40 days earlier by the cross and the empty tomb. For the price of redemption had been paid in the death of the Son of God and the promise of the Holy Ghost had been secured by his resurrection.

The 120 had to wait only until the Day of Pentecost for God has chosen this day for the birth of the church, and the Holy Ghost was the agent of this birth. Originally called, the Feast of Weeks that celebrated the grain harvest, the Day of Pentecost came to be recognized as the time to celebrate the giving of the law on Mount Sinai, which was the basis of the Old Testament Covenant. With the outpouring of the spirit in the New Testament, the day of Pentecost marked the beginning of the New Covenant, a covenant purchased and Sanctified by the blood of the son of God, Jesus Christ.

They were anointed men for ministry and mission, but they could not receive the regeneration, life-giving experience that is ours in the church era. God has something better for us, on this side of Calvary, the indwelling presence of His spirit.

As long as God's church is on this Earth, the spirit will be the agent by whom men are sanctified, regenerated and sealed. Without His presence, there is NO SALVATION. Unless the spirit draws, convicts, baptizes us, we will remain lost in our sins.
