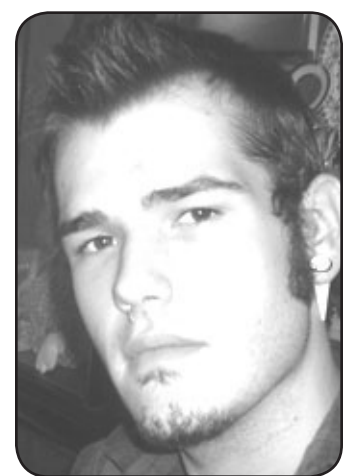
Nicklas W. Spurgeon, 26
