It first appears in spring as a vertical crack on the tree trunk, usually on the southwest side. A vertical crack opens and the bark begins to peel in spring, long after the damage actually occurred. This type of damage is commonly restricted to young, recently transplanted landscape trees and is not Something that we associate with the same species
